## CAUTION AGAINST FALSE INFORMATION

The Central Bank of Kenya (CBK) is aware that malicious actors may attempt to circulate erroneous information on online and other channels about the banking system. The banking sector in Kenya remains stable and resilient, and is adequately capitalised. All customers should continue transacting as normal.

CBK has not issued any press release, or other information with regard to the operation of the banking sector or any other element of its mandate. We thus advise the public to disregard any such purported information.

The intent behind these malicious attempts is usually to induce panic, leading to action which may destabilise the market. We wish to emphasise that creating or circulating such information is in contravention of several laws including the Computer Misuse and Cybercrimes Act, and will lead to criminal prosecutions.
